Purpose of the Annual Parish Meeting.

The purpose of the annual meeting is to explain to the parish what has been going on in the last year and enable parishioners to speak on any matter of local interest.

Who can attend?

The Annual Parish Meeting is open to all electors of Welsh Newton Parish.

This is NOT a meeting of the Parish Council, where electors who are not Councillors have no automatic right to speak (although Welsh Newton & Llanrothal Parish Council does have a set time during Parish Council meetings when electors can raise matters of concern to them).
